Tournament Duration: In the best of three (3) system, the duration of the contest shall be three rounds of

two minutes each with a one-minute rest period between rounds. However, a 4th round of one minute will not be conducted as the Golden round. In case of a tie score for corresponding round, the round winner shall be decided by the Article

15 of WT Competition rules & interpretation

The duration of each round may be adjusted to 1 minute, 1 minute 30 second or 2 minutes at the sole discretion of the Technical Delegate for the pertinent

Championships.

- ★ Overall team winners will be decided according to the numbers of gold medals that each division / team won. In case that the numbers of gold medals are the same between the teams, it will then depend on the number of silver medals, or otherwise the number of the bronze medals. If the number of bronze medals are still the same, then it will then be decided by the number of games from the gold winners. The top four participating teams will receive trophies.

Indemnities

- a. It shall be the responsibility of the respective national association/club to ensure that their contestants have validly completed the "Health Declaration Form" and that they are in possession of a valid entry visa. Any injury, damage, losses of whatever type or kind arising in any way in connection with the Championships and activities relating thereof (including without limitation, the farewell dinner) shall be the sole responsibility of the respective national association/club and/or the contestants (as the case may be).
- b. It shall be the responsibility of the respective national association/club to ensure that all officials and contestants are adequately and effectively covered by insurance.
- c. National association/club and/or contestants without proper participating documentation and/or effective insurance coverage shall not be allowed to compete.

Costumes for Contestants

- a. KPNP electronic gear recognized by The World Taekwondo ("WT") is the official electronic gear in the competition.
- b. Contestants shall bring their own KPNP electronic socks
- c. Contestants shall wear a Taekwondo uniform (Dobok) recognized by WT.

 *WT recognized protective equipment of head gear, groin guard, glove, forearm &

*WT recognized protective equipment of head gear, groin guard, glove, forearm & shin guards shall be brought by the participating contestants for personal use and groin guard shall be worn inside the Taekwondo uniform. Mouthpiece must be worn.

d. The Organizer will provide the electronic protectors and electronic head gear and the contestants shall wear the designated trunk protector of the pertinent weight category. Wearing of the WT recognized Taekwondo uniform (Dobok) and protective equipment will be checked at the inspection desk prior to entering the contest area. Any contestant wearing unrecognized uniform (Dobok) or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.

Weight-in

- a. Weight-in for contestants by Cities will be held at 4:00p.m. on 8th March 2024 at **B P International Hotel** (No.8 Austin Road, Tsim Sha Tsui, Kowloon).
- b. During weight-in, the male contestants shall wear underpants and the female contestants shall wear underpants and brassiere. However, weight-in can be conducted in the nude in case the contestant wishes to do so.
- c. Weight-in shall be conducted once. However, one more weight-in will be granted within the time limit if the contestant did not qualify at the first time.
